


StrataShield Flashing Tape

Self-adhesive waterproofing tape

Product overview

StrataShield Flashing Tape is a self adhesive waterproofing tape manufactured from high quality elastomeric modified bitumen and laminated with aluminium foil.

StrataShield Flashing Tape can be applied internally or externally and is ideal for use in a variety of areas including roofs, skylights, chimneys, walls, porches and conservatories. It is compatible with most common building materials and can also be used for a range of emergency roof repairs.

Storage	Keep at temperatures between 5°C in a dry, ventilated, closed area. Rolls must be protected from water, frost and heavy weather conditions.

Preparation

All surfaces must be smooth, dry, clean and free of oil, grease, rust and other foreign materials. Deep cracks or fissures (+3mm) and very rough surfaces should be filled with bitumen repair mastic.

Application of a suitable bitumen primer is recommended in order to improve adhesion on porous substrates and in cold or damp weather conditions. In addition, adhesion will be greatly improved in low temperature conditions (below 10°C) by gently warming the tape and surface with a warm air blower.

Do not apply in temperatures below 5°C.

Application guidelines

Cut the StrataShield Flashing Tape to the required length. Remove the backing paper and lightly press into place. Overlap by at least 25mm and use a wallpaper roller or similar to ensure a good, even contact is made with the surface and also to smooth the tape.

If required StrataShield Flashing Tape can be overpainted with exterior grade paints, although slight staining may occur at the edges.
